After obtaining MA in Social and Economic Development form the Graduate School of Public and International Affairs of the University of Pittsburgh, started her career in the field operations of the international cooperation as a Junior Professional Officer (JPO) of the United Nations Development Program (UNDP) in The Gambia (1984 – 1986), West Africa. Joined JOICFP for a short period, then she left for rural Ethiopia to work as a project coordinator of the rehabilitation and reconstruction project of the Japan Red Cross (1988-1991). She has been working with JOICFP since 1991 and involved in the various reproductive health (RH) projects in Africa and Asia regions supported IPPF and UNFPA, also served as team leader of JICA projects, e.g. a RH project in Vietnam for 5 and half years, an adolescent RH project in Nicaragua for 4 years, involved in ODA projects in Ghana and Tanzania, coaching younger staffs in project management. She was appointed as Executive Director in 2016, and holds the post of Board Director since 2017, supervising the overall JOICFP operations.
